

# Halloween Boogie Candy Box



## a Overview

Surprise your ghoulish tricksters by allowing them to pick a treat from the tree! You can whip up these cute treat holders in a matter of minutes!

## a Supplies

- **Ink:** classic basic black ink pad
- **Paper:** basic black, only orange, whisper white 8.5x11 cardstock, white/neon orange/black/neon green 8.5x11 copy paper (for the box)
- **Stamps:** boogie eyes
- **Accessories:** marvy giga square 2"x2" scallop punch, 3/16" corner rounder punch, 13/8" square punch, crop-a-dile, green grossgrain ribbon, googlie eyes small, bold brights II eyelets, liquid glue, watercolor pencils, blender pen

## a Directions

1. Cut & Score 8.5"x2.75" strips according to template directions.
2. Carefully fold 8.5"x2.75" strips into box, glue using liquid glue and let dry.
3. Punch 2 scallop squares for each box you desire to make using basic black cardstock.
4. Stamp images onto whisper white (use boogie monster stamp) & only orange (use saying stamp) cardstock using basic black classic ink and boogie eyes rubber stamp set.
5. Color stamped images using watercolor pencils and blender pen.
6. Punch out images using 1 3/8 " square punch. (turn punch upside down to center image before punching!)
7. Glue stamped image card stock to scallop square cardstock using liquid glue.
8. Glue boogie eyes onto stamped images using liquid glue.
9. Glue scalloped squares to paper box – ensuring seam is covered by scalloped square
10. Using Crop-a-dile attach eyelet to each side of paper box.
11. Thread gross grain ribbon through box to make handle
12. Stuff with treats and goodies!

# Halloween Boogie Candy Box

## a Box Template

- 1. Cut 8.5"x2.75" strips using copy paper.
- Score 2.75" every 2" along width of strip.
- Score 1" along length of strip.
- Cut out corner of strip that is shaded.
- Snip 1" along 2.75" score lines.
- Using 3/16" corner rounder punch, round corners at each box bottom flap and small side for a more finished look.
- Fold box together and glue box bottom and small side using liquid glue. For a fancier box, fold box bottom flaps so that they interlock.
- Let dry.
