



Boogie Trading Cards

Instructions:

1. Print out front page of jokes on 1 sheet of whisper white cardstock.
2. Print out back page of jokes on unprinted side of whisper white cardstock.
3. Cut the joke cards 2.5"w x3"h.
4. Stamp Image onto front of card above joke question. I used Boogie Eyes stamp set...Do not color in the image... that's half the fun!
5. Neatly stack up cards and place cards front side facing front into small cellophane bag.
6. Fold ½" of the top small cellophane bag and fasten with mini glue dots so that the bag is sealed shut.
7. Cut a 3" by 2" strip of designer series paper – I used creepy crawly! Fold in half to fit bag and attach each side to cellophane bag to make a bag topper.
8. Punch using a scallop circle only orange or basic black cardstock.
9. Stamp Halloween image onto whisper white cardstock. Color in image. Punch out colored image using 1 3/8" circle.
10. Attach 1 3/8" colored image circle to the punched out scallop circle using a stampin' dimensional. Attach then to middle of front bag topper with mini glue dots.
11. Cut a 4" length of black gingham ribbon. Tie two crayons together with ribbon making a cute bow. Trim the bow ends neatly.
12. Attach crayons with a pop up glue dot to the front middle of the cellophane bag...
13. Voila – you now have a really cute gift to give a special 1st, 2nd or 3rd grader!
14. Enjoy watching them be creative while they color in the cards to give to someone very special!
